

Privacy Policy

The Information which We Collect

You may browse our website without disclosing personal data. However, if you register, and/or order or book products and/or services from us either online or by contacting us by e-mail, we will collect some or all of the following personal information from you so that we can fulfil your order and contact you in case there is a query with your order:

Your Full name;

Date of Birth;

Residential address;

Company name;

Email address;

Telephone number;

Your debit or credit card number; and Expiry date and other relevant information to allow us to collect payment.

How We Use Your Personal Information

In addition to providing our services and products to you as set out above, we will also use your information for marketing purposes and credit control purposes.

How We Share Your Personal Information

We may share your personal information with other companies in our group (as defined in our General Terms of Business), for any of the above.

In order to provide services to you we may be required to pass your personal information to parties located outside of the European Economic Area in countries which do not have data protection laws equivalent to those in the United Kingdom. Where this is the case we will take reasonable steps to ensure the privacy of your information. Except in the situations listed above or as required by law or other regulation, we will not pass, disclose, rent or sell your personal information (other than any personal information which is already publicly available and which is incorporated into our search products) to any third party without your prior written consent.

Protecting Your Information

When you order from us we use a secure server. All personal and credit card information is encrypted using Secure Sockets Layer (SSL) technology before it is sent to us over the internet.

We have a Data Protection Policy and strict internal procedures designed to protect your personal information from unauthorised access, improper use, alteration, unintended destruction or other loss.

How We Treat Cookies

Cookies are small files which some websites transfer onto the hard drive of your computer.
